§ 1

1. Organisers:

- The National Hairdressing and Cosmetic Committee – Polish Craft Association (OKF-K ZRP)
- Wielkopolska Chamber of Crafts in Poznań

Co-organisers:

- Międzynarodowe Targi Poznańskie
- "Anita Folaron" Make-up and Styling School,
- Long Hair International Hair Extension Championship.

2. Contestants take part in the Championship in two competitions:

- a. **Juniors** – young hairdressers under 21 years of age. Contestants are entered by chambers of crafts, guilds, schools and other institutions and organisations.



- b. **Seniors** – persons from the age of 21 with the title of journeyman or an equivalent degree, or a master's diploma in the hairdressing industry.
3. Competition: make-up, hair extension, thickening and styling – without restrictions.
 4. Competition: barbering – from the age of 15. The competition is open to:
 - a. hairdressing school students.
 - b. working barbers, men's or women's and men's hairdressers.
 5. Application for participation in the Championship:
 - a. Completed **APPLICATION FORM** should be sent at the latest by **14.04.2017** to the Championship Organisational Office: Cech Rzemiosł Różnych (Sundry Crafts Guild) in Poznań

 - b. The Regulations of the Polish Championship and the **APPLICATION FORM** are available at: www.zrp.pl and www.crr.com.pl
 - c. The Organisational Office confirms acceptance of the application. When registering the contestant presents documents confirming their identity, and in the case of Seniors original or a copy of a document confirming professional qualifications and proof of payment of the entry fee.
 - d. **Entry fee:**
 - Juniors – PLN 120.00 for the Polish Championship or – PLN 60.00 for selected competition
 - Seniors – the Polish Champion title – PLN 300.00 (salons affiliated to guilds) and PLN 350.00 others
 - Seniors – PLN 250.00 for selected competition
 - 2 make-up competitions – PLN 250.00
 - Hair extension and thickening – PLN 200.00
 - Barbering – PLN 350.00 (guild salons) and PLN 400 – others
 - Imagination-Class-Style – PLN 350.00 (guild salons) and PLN 400.00 for others.

In the Championship contestants are **required** to use training heads bearing the **OKF-K ZRP logo**. In the absence of the head, you must pay a license fee to Prospector sp. z o.o.: in the amount of **PLN 150.00**.

§ 2

1. To compete for the **Polish Champion title** participation in competitions is required:
 - a. **JUNIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF WOMEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Casual hairstyle – to be combed
 - Evening hairstyle – based on casual hairstyle
 - b. **JUNIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF MEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Styling – long hair
 - Trendy short haircut and styling – from long hair
 - c. **SENIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF WOMEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Casual hairstyle – to be combed
 - Evening hairstyle – based on casual hairstyle
 - d. **SENIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF MEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Structural hairstyle – waves
 - Classic haircut and styling
 - e. **PROFESSIONAL MAKE-UP** – in two competitions on models
 - Linear Make-up
 - "Starry Woman" Make-up
 - f. **HAIR EXTENSION AND THICKENING** – one competition – on a model.
 - g. **BARBERING** – ONE COMPETITION – ON A MODEL.

The winners of the first three places in the competition for the Polish Hairdressing Champion title receive medals and cups. These awards are presented on the main stage of the Championship.

All participants receive diplomas.

2. **Individual competitions:**

- a. **JUNIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF WOMEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Monroe-like waves and rings hairstyle – grade I
 - Wedding hairstyle – long hair
 - Avant-garde styling
- b. **JUNIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF MEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Styling – long hair
 - Trendy short haircut and styling – from long hair
- c. **SENIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF WOMEN'S HAIRDRESSING**



- Avant-garde styling
- d. **SENIORS IN THE CATEGORY OF MEN'S HAIRDRESSING**
 - Structural hairstyle – waves
 - Classic haircut and styling
- e. **JUNIORS / SENIORS: New women's and men's competition: IMAGINATION-CLASS-STYLE** – solely on models.

Competition in the category of women's and men's hairdressing only on dummy heads (for juniors). Seniors have freedom of choice (model or dummy head).

§ 3

1. To evaluate the tasks in § 2 and § 3 the National Hairdressing and Cosmetic Committee (OKF-K ZRP) appointed five Juries:
 - a. women's hairdressing – up to ten people,
 - b. men's hairdressing – up to ten people,
 - c. make- up – up to five people,
 - d. hair extension – up to three people.
 - e. men's hairdressing – barbering – up to five people.
2. To ensure that the Championship runs efficiently and in compliance with the Regulations, the National Hairdressing and Cosmetic Committee (OKF-K ZRP) appointed five Juries
 - a. women's hairdressing – up to five people,
 - b. men's hairdressing – up to five people,
 - c. make- up – up to five people,
 - d. hair extension – up to three people.
 - e. men's hairdressing – barbering – up to five people.
3. The Juries mentioned in points 1 and 2 are subject to the regulations established by the National Hairdressing and Cosmetic Committee ZRP.

§ 4

1. The competition tasks will be graded in the 30-point scale. The lower limit of points will be determined on the day of the Championship according to the number of participants. Each juror must grant three highest scores, i.e. 30, 29 and 28 points and three lowest scores, i.e. depending on the defined lower limit.
2. In the event of non-compliance with the Regulations, each member of the Jury has the right to grant up to 3 penalty points for every failure. The contestants may check the number of penalty points in the results list.
3. In disputed cases the final word rests with the Chairman of the Jury.



§ 5

1. The place taken by contestants for the title of the Polish Champion is determined by the sum of points from the Jury taking into account penalty points:

- Juniors – women's – two competitions
- Juniors – men's – two competitions
- Seniors – women's – two competitions
- Seniors – men's – two competitions
- Make-up – two competitions
- Hair extension and thickening – one competition
- Barbering – one competition.

2. The place taken by contestants taking part in Individual Competitions is determined by the sum of points for that competition taking into account penalty points.

§ 6

In accordance with Regulation of the Minister of National Education Journal of Laws, item 89 of 10.01.2017, winners of the Polish Championships are exempt from the practical part of the apprentice examination in the winning competition.

§ 7

The participants and models consent to the use of their image and work done for the promotion, marketing and documentation of the Championship and MTP.

§ 8

The participant declares that he/she is the author and holds copyright to (haircuts/styling) entered in the Championship within the meaning of the copyright law.

§ 9

The participant takes part in the Championship at his/her own expense (materials, model, transport, accommodation, etc.), excluding accommodation for juniors.

§ 10

Each participant in the Championship declares that he/she is familiar with the Code of Ethics annexed to the Regulations and that he/she undertakes to observe its provisions.
